

## Life to Eagle Process York District

- Life Scout works with his Scoutmaster/Troop Advancement Chair to select an appropriate Eagle Project.
- Life Scout works with a beneficiary to come to a project agreement.
- Life Scout fills out the Eagle Proposal, using the most recent form, [http://www.scouting.org/filestore/pdf/512-927\\_fillable.pdf](http://www.scouting.org/filestore/pdf/512-927_fillable.pdf)
- Life Scout reviews his proposal with his beneficiary, Scout Master, and Troop Advancement Chair, obtaining their approvals.
- Life Scout submits his proposal to the York District Advancement Committee.
  - Drop proposal off at Scout Store
  - Drop proposal off at Advancement Chair's home
  - Mail proposal to Advancement Chair's home
  - Bring proposal to York District Round Table meeting
- District Advancement Committee reviews project on the 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of each month, unless noted otherwise.
- District Advancement Committee will evaluate the proposal and the proposal with a letter will be returned to the Life Scout. Letter types:
  - No Project – usually non recoverable. Examples: project to an inappropriate beneficiary, project is not permitted in the “Guide to Safe Scouting”. Probably needs a new project.
  - Not Enough Information – unclear if it is viable project or not. Examples: proposal is unclear as to what is being done, proposal is not clear what the leadership is. Give more details and resubmit to next Advancement Committee meeting.
  - Viable project, but need more information – need a bit more information. Examples: sketch of what is being proposed, follow “Guide to Safe Scouting”. Adjust project and submit to District Advancement Chair for approval.
  - Approved with adjustments – Project is approvable but minor adjustment is needed. Examples: Same as above, but very minor. Note adjustments in proposal.
  - Approved – No adjustments needed.
- Once approved, scout performs project and completes Eagle requirements.
- Life Scout fills out Eagle Application – [http://www.scouting.org/filestore/pdf/512-728\\_web.pdf](http://www.scouting.org/filestore/pdf/512-728_web.pdf). Don't forget Life's Ambition Statement.
- Life Scout requests references.
- Life Scouts submits completed project with Eagle Application to Council for signoff, bring package to Scout Store and place on 2nd shelf.
- Once proposal has Council signoff, it is given to District Advancement Chair to schedule Eagle Board.
- District Advancement Chair contacts ScoutMaster to schedule board on the next possible 4th Wednesday of the month. Troop must supply two board members, district will supply one.
